Language, Literacy and Communication

Mathematics & Numeracy

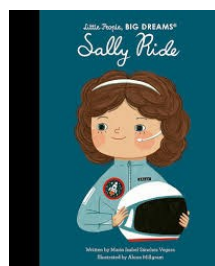
Class 2 will be exploring place value, moving onto addition and subtraction.

We will be learning how to measure distance and size, thinking about the scale of our solar system and the size of the planets.



Humanities

Class 2 will be discovering our solar system, looking at the moon, the planets and moving onto stars and constellations. We will be learning about important people who have paved the way for future space exploration.



Expressive Arts



In class 2 we will be exploring the stars and different artists who have used the awe and wonder of space to create fascinating artwork. Including Oliver Jeffers and Van Gogh.

Health & Wellbeing

We will be attempting to complete a 26.2 miles walk as part of our space explorer training. Learning about how exercise is an important part of daily life.

Class 2 will continue to focus on our well-being by referring to the 5 ways to well-being regularly.



Science & Technology

We will be discovering all about our solar system and the planets within. We will also be learning about the properties of materials and which ones would be most suitable to wear in space. We will be using our designing skills throughout this topic.
