Dosbarth 3 / Class 3

Language, Literacy and Communication

This term, pupils will be reading 'Cosmic' by Frank Cottrell-Boyce and developing our inference, deduction and comprehension skills. We will also be looking at a variety of different genres including reports, writing to persuade, poetry and balanced arguments.

In Welsh lessons, students will work on creating a fact file about an astronaut, describing a planet, reading Welsh stories connected to our Space theme, and composing an email.



Mathematics & Numeracy

Pupils will look at place value and practise reading and writing numbers in words and figures and learn what each digit represents. They will solve problems involving more than one operation and carryout mathematical investigations.



We will also continue to revise and secure our multiplication tables.

Expressive Arts

Pupils will look at the Space work of Artist Peter Thorpe and create some of their very own abstract art. They will experiment with a range of techniques including colour mixing and collaging.



We will also be creating our own space diorama.

Humanities

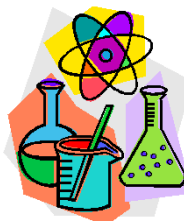
Class 3 will be looking at space exploration and how many countries are visitors of the ISS. Pupils will enhance their maths and drawing their own solar system model on the yard. We will be looking at what astronauts eat and even having a go at sampling the food ourselves. We will look at the constellations and make our very own constellation craft.



Science & Technology

Pupils will have the opportunity to create their own news report using Greenscreen and will show how we get the four seasons using coding on Scratch.

In Science we will conduct a variety of investigations, including what variables affect the size of a meteorite crater.



Health & Wellbeing

Pupils will be learning how to play cricket and the important rules and skills needed to play a successful game. We will be looking at what it means to show good sportsmanship and getting outdoors as much as possible to promote good health and wellbeing.
